NOMINATION FORMS

Only official nomination forms (or photocopies thereof) will be accepted for all categories. Computer produced forms, designed in the appropriate format are also acceptable.

ALL NOMINATION FORMS must be forwarded to your REGIONAL ASSOCIATION. The Regional Association is responsible for forwarding them to Louise Cadieux.

➔ REJECTIONS

The Provincial Selection Committee may, at its discretion, reject nominations for the following reasons:

- Incomplete forms (ex : photo not included with the form);
- Missing information;
- Two nominations for the same categorie (exception categories with scoring);
- Late entries ;
- Hand-written forms (forms must be type-written).

GENERAL COMMENTS

- a) The decisions of the Provincial Selection Committee are taken by a majority vote of the members present at the meeting.
- b) The Provincial Selection Committee may submit its own nominees.
- c) The club and regional association selection committees should include members of the executive committee, the Director of the Recreation Programs, the Public Relations director, the STARSkate' director and one or two representatives of the clubs not sitting on the Regional Association committee. Persons sitting on the club, regional association or provincial selection committees MAY be nominated for the current year, however, they MAY NOT participate in the selection of the nominee or recipient of the award for the category in which they have been nominated.
- d) Each club must form a committee for the selection of the "*BMO Financial Group skater of the Year*". The committee should consist of no less than three members at least one of which is a Skate Canada NCCP certified coach (as required by Skate Canada). EACH REGIONAL ASSOCIATION MUST SUBMIT ONLY ONE NOMINATION IN THIS CATEGORY.
- e) If a skater is the best in more than one category, the skater MAY AND SHOULD BE nominated in all categories.
- f) Regions must send ONLY ONE NOMINATION for each category. If more than one nomination is submitted for a category all nominations submitted by the regional association for that category WILL BE REJECTED (exception categories with scoring).
- g) Except for the Hall of Fame, all nominees must BE AFFILIATED MEMBERS OF A CLUB WITHIN THE SECTION AND A MEMBER OF SKATE CANADA; registration numbers must appear on the official nomination forms.

A PHOTO (3" x 5" minimum - *color or black & white clearly identify on the back*)

Must be included with each nomination form.

International Medalists

Reserved for skaters who have been successful at the International Level. (medalists)

Elizabeth-Swan Award (synchronized skating)

The selection is the sole responsibility of the Provincial Selection Committee.

Skate Canada Competitive Coach Award of Excellence

The selection is the sole responsibility of the Provincial Selection Committee with the coaches Committee.

Special Recognition/Lifetime Achievement Award

The selection is the sole responsibility of the Provincial Selection Committee
