PRIVATE WITH COACH

JUNIOR: Blocks 1, 2,6,13,19,20,22 *Badges 4 and up completed and No freestyle test passed*

INTERMEDIATE: Blocks 1, 2, 3,4,6,7,13,19,21
Preliminary &/or Junior Bronze Freestyle test passed

SENIOR: Blocks 1,2,4,5,6,7,11,12,13,17,18,19....
Senior Bronze Freestyle test and higher passed

BASE RATE = \$100 PLUS price of each Block chosen within Category. A minimum of 2 Blocks is required

A participation fee of \$25 / per skater, charged by the city of Brossard for the use of the ice, is a compulsory fee and is included in the above mentioned registration fees.

ATTENTION

- **No changes of Blocks will be permitted after the 15th of October 2010.**
- No reimbursements will be made after October 1st 2010, except for the Patinage Plus 3-5 year olds whose limit date is October 15th 2010.
- C.P.A. Brossard will retain a \$60 administration fee for any reimbursements requested before these dates.

All returned cheques will be subject to a \$30 fee for administrative purposes.

UNIFORM REGULATIONS

Patinage Plus (PP 3-5 years old):

For safety reasons, all children are required to wear a **hockey or bicycle helmet** at all times, as well as **gloves or mittens**, otherwise they will not be allowed on the ice..

Patinage Plus (PP 5 years and up):

- A **blue skirt (girl)** or **blue pants (boys)**. These articles remain the property of the Brossard F.S.C. and must be returned to the club, washed and in good condition at the end of the season or at the departure of the skater if he/she does not finish the season.

A deposit of \$20 will be payable for each article of clothing lent and will be reimbursed when the article is returned at the end of the season.

- A white sweatshirt with the colour logo of the club: cost \$20. This is yours to keep.
- Girls need to buy **beige leotards**, in any skating or dance boutique.
- All children **below level 4** are required to wear, for safety reasons, a **hockey or bicycle helmet**



COURSES

GROUP COURSES

Group courses in Patinage Plus (PP) are taught by Skate Canada certified coaches with the aid of our Program Assistants. For the Star Group (Semi-Private) program, the group courses are given by Skate Canada certified coaches and assisted by the Program Assistants. This applies to all the non-private course skaters.

PRIVATE COURSES

For private courses you must make arrangements directly with a Skate Canada certified coach who appears on our CPAB COACHES LIST. Be advised that these arrangements should be made before the start of the season in accordance with your child's skating schedule. You are responsible for paying all coaching costs directly to the coach.

Patinage Plus (PP 5+) Blocks 8,9,15,16

Star Group(semi-private) Blocks 10 and 23 ALL 6 PP Levels completed

Junior: Blocks 1,2,6,13,19,20,22 PP badge 4 received & higher, No freestyle test passed

Intermediate: Blocks 1,2,3,4,,7,13,19,21 Preliminary &/or Junior Bronze Freestyle test passed

Senior: Blocks 1,2,4,5,6,7,11,12,13,17,18,19 Senior Bronze Freestyle test and higher passed

Projet Scolaire: Are open blocks and free to CPAB skaters only, who are registered as full time members (minimum two blocks):

- Patinage Plus badge 4 and up with a coach and in a lesson
- Star Group with your coach on the ice
- Junior, Intermediate & Senior

ALL BROSSARD RESIDENTS MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING AT REGISTRATION:

- a) A completed registration form
- b) A photocopy of skater's VALID Servicarte
- c) A photocopy of a VALID driver's license (proof of residence)
- d) Two (2) completed medical forms

ALL NON-RESIDENTS OF BROSSARD MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING AT REGISTRATION:

- a) A completed registration form
- b) Name of home club: _____
- c) A photocopy of skater's VALID Access Card
- d) A photocopy of a VALID driver's license (proof of residence)
- e) A photocopy of skater's Skate Canada Card
- f) Two (2) completed medical forms

NOTE: All non-residence are required to pay a base rate of \$60.00 plus double (2X) the ice rate (2 block minimum)

PARCELS

Any skater wishing to purchase parcels during the 2010-2011 skating season will be required to have a parcel voucher prior to accessing the ice. These vouchers will be sold in singles, sets of 5 or 10. They are at a cost of \$4.00 per voucher. These vouchers are transferable. Any voucher that is not redeemed during the skating season can be reimbursed to the purchaser.
